Mary was 'in trouble' – unmarried, pregnant and (who would believe her story) – an angel speaking to her! And to top it all, Joseph wanted to end the engagement.

Mary ran away, she went to her cousin, Elizabeth, an older wiser woman, maybe she would help her.....

We all get afraid in life – at school, at work, lots of different situations and even at home! Facing unknown situations can be scary. Where can you go!



There are people who we can trust to help us. Often an older wiser Christian is always a good place to turn.

Thinking how Mary felt, let's look at something Mary said:


I am glad because of God my Saviour. <sup>48</sup> He cares for me, his humble servant.

Here is a definition of Mercy:


'compassion or forgiveness shown towards someone whom it is within one's power to punish or harm.'

Everlasting Father is a name given to Mary's son by the prophet Isaiah hundreds of years before his birth.

We can be assured the promises Mary spoke of before the birth of Jesus are everlasting and hold true for us today, caring for his children for an everlasting eternity.

Have you put your Trust in Mary's son. He will care for you and show you mercy and compassion.



We will close by singing the words of Mary in the hymn 'Tell out my Soul'
